PROCEDURAL MATTERS:

BOG 2022.41.01	<i>Opening remarks of the Chairman, Board of Governors, IIT Patna.</i>
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The Chairman greeted the members and expressed his gratitude for attending the meeting physically, after Covid -19 pandemic. The Chairman also directed the Secretary, BoG to prepare an annual planner for conducting the FC and BoG meetings on quarterly basis (online or physical mode).

The Chairman called the meeting to order.

BOG 2022.41.02	<i>To confirm the minutes of 2022/40th meeting of the Board of Governors held on 31st March 2022.</i>
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Minutes of 2022/40th meeting of the Board of Governors, approved by Hon'ble Chairman were circulated to all the members and no comment was received from any member.

Minutes of 2022/40th meeting of the Board of Governors, as circulated were approved and confirmed by the Board.

BOG 2022.41.03	<i>To consider and approve the Action Taken Report (ATR) on minutes of the 2022/40th & past meetings of the BoG.</i>
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Action taken report and updated status on items of 2022/40th & past meetings of the BoG is given as under:

Item No.: BOG 2020.36.18

Title in brief:

To report the status of various Sponsored Research Projects & Consultancy Projects in the Institute, approved earlier by the sponsoring agencies.

Board's Observation during 40th meeting: A presentation, highlighting the significant growth in submission of project proposals related to sponsored research and consultancy was made by the A. Dean R&D.

Need for setting an actionable, measurable and quantifiably defined yearly goal was re-emphasized by the Board. A target of 30% appreciation in number of submitted projects and double of the present number in 03 years was fixed. The number should also go up in terms of value.

Action Taken: Continuous efforts are being made to increase the submission of research proposals to various funding agencies for Grants-in Aid to carry out research at IIT Patna on challenging areas of societal concern. The Board was reported that number and value of projects has increased to the tune of 26 % in FY 2021-22. Institute has planned to increase this number and project funding value to much higher level in FY 2022-23. A comparative summary status of the project proposals submitted till date is hereunder:

Board's Observation during 41st meeting: Board noted and advised to perform better and R&D performance be considered as the prime benchmark in deciding performers/non-performers in the course of career advancement at every level in faculty candidate (shortlisting, selection and confirmation) in compliance of 7th CPC Order (F.No. 15-4/2017-TC Dated: 27.10.2017).

Item No.: BOG 2022.40.06

Title in brief: *To consider the confirmation/regularization of non-teaching employees.*

Board's observation during 40th meeting :

Before 2018, at IIT Patna, appointments on non-faculty positions were being made on contract of 3/5 years, after which the employees were confirmed in their posts following due process, based on satisfactory performance. This condition of likely confirmation after the contract period is over, was explicitly mentioned in respective vacancy advertisement. The principles of transparency and open and fair competition were never violated, since the applicants knew right from the advertisement stage (No. IITP/RECT./002/2016 dated 17.08.2016), like in case of probation- that confirmation will be done based on performance. In their offer letter too (Clause 01 of offer letter no. R/IITP/RECT./2017/133 dated 01.03.2017), condition of confirmation/regularization was mentioned. From 2018, the institute shifted completely to probation-based appointments.

In line with the condition of confirmation mentioned in advt. and offer of appointment, people taken on board were confirmed with the approval of Chairman BoG subject to satisfactory performance evaluated by committee as per BoG approved procedure. Such confirmations were also got ratified in subsequent meetings of the BoG.

While ratifying 02 such cases of confirmation in its meeting held on 10th October, 2020, the BoG directed to take legal opinion on the process adopted by the Institute before remaining similarly placed cases are taken up for confirmation. The legal opinion of Institute empaneled advocate was placed before the Board in its meeting held on 13th February 2021.

Subsequently, the opinions of 02 senior advocates viz; Mr. Naresh Dixit, Senior Standing Counsel, Hon'ble High Court Patna and Mr. V.K.Upadhyay, Senior Advocate, Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad were also perused by the Board.

A committee as under was constituted for examining the matter in totality.

Report of the committee was accepted by the Board with note of dissent from two members, Prof. Yogesh Singh, Vice –Chancellor, University of Delhi and Prof. Kailash Chandra Sharma, Ex-Vice Chancellor, Kurushetra University.

The Board directed that all remaining contract employees may be considered for confirmation/regularization following due procedure as per central government rules and regulations.

Action taken: Cases are being taken up as per central government rules and regulations.

Board's observation during 41st meeting: Noted.

Item No.: BOG 2022.40.07

Title in brief: *To consider the report of Committee constituted to review the RR & PP document of IIT Patna.*

Board's observation during 40th meeting :

A few categories of Non-teaching employees of the Institute represented to consider their cases for next auto-upgradation after completion of minimum residency period, in line with Govt. of India guidelines. This provision of auto-upgradation; for example, in case of Deputy Registrars, is not the part of our RR & PP document, though implemented in many IITs. A need was therefore felt to review the RR & PP document of IIT Patna, approved by the BoG in its 28th meeting, for addressing the ambiguities with regards to superseding Govt. of India guidelines and other issues as may surface during the review. A committee comprising following members was constituted by the Director to review the document.

1. Prof. Rajiv Prakash, Dean (R&D), IIT BHU
2. Mr. Prashant Garg, Registrar, IIT Roorkee
3. Associate Dean, Administration, IIT Patna
4. Registrar, IIT Patna
5. Liaison Officer (SC/ST), IIT Patna

While perusing the recommendations made by the committee, the Board desired to have more information from older IITs in similar matters.

In the matter of upgradation of Deputy Registrars from pay level 12 to pay level 13 after 05 years of service as Deputy Registrar, the MoE (erstwhile MHRD) vide letter dated

02nd November 2017 addressed to the UGC, Clause 2 (i) provisioned the placement of Deputy Registrars at pay level 13, after completion of 05 years of service as Deputy Registrar or equivalent. The said provision has been adopted by almost all IITs. Relevant documents collected from IIT Kharagpur, IIT Madras, IIT Delhi, IIT Kanpur, IIT Guwahati, IIT BHU, IIT (ISM) Dhanbad, IIT Roorkee, IIT Gandhinagar, IIT Jodhpur, IIT Bhubaneswar and IIT Mandi were presented before the Board. Information in respect of other positions like Medical Officer, Sports Officer etc. has not been received yet.

Recommendations made by the committee and relevant supporting documents were perused by the Board. During discussion on this agenda, one of the members raised issue on appointment of the Registrar at IIT Patna on permanent position is not in line with other IITs.

Board decided to accept comment from the MoE and directed to re-frame guidelines which should be in line with prevalent practices followed by other IITs.

Action taken: As per extant guidelines of the MoE, the financial upgradation in next pay-level has been granted to the eligible Deputy Registrars. Information related to other positions is being collected. Various representations pertaining to inconsistencies in the existing RR&PP of IIT Patna have been received. Existing RR&PP may be modified/repealed once all such inconsistencies are examined and removed through a committee in the larger interest of employees' welfare.

Board's observation during 41st meeting: A committee including expert member (s) from other IIT (s), may be constituted by the Director to examine all representations and to submit the recommendations on required changes in existing RR&PP, in line with the Statutes of IIT Patna and Govt. of India guidelines. The committee should also look at the RR&PP of other IITs to take best out of those in the larger interest of employees' welfare. The committee should submit its report by 15th February 2023 which may be shared with the BoG for comments/consent by 28th February 2023.

Item No.: BOG 2022.40.11

Title in brief: *To ratify the policy and guidelines for partnered Certificate Courses under Continuing Education Program (CEP).*

Board's observation during 40th meeting :

A need for clearly defined Policy and Guidelines for proposing CEP Courses (in partnership mode) was often expressed by many faculty members. A four-member committee comprising of the A. Dean Resources, A. Dean R&D, HoD CEE, and Dr. Udit Satija was accordingly formed on 25/01/2022 to frame the guidelines for running CEP courses in partnership mode. The final recommendations of the committee and the concerned application form as approved in the meeting (23/02/2022) with A. Deans under the chairmanship of Director IIT Patna were placed before the Board. These documents were also vetted by the CA and the lawyer empaneled by IIT Patna. The

policy has been developed keeping in mind the following cardinal principles:

- The CEP should build and propagate the "Brand IIT Patna".
- The CEP should be professionally satisfying and financially rewarding to the hard working faculty members of the IIT Patna.
- The CEP should contribute towards financial sustainability by significant resource generation for IIT Patna.

A presentation explaining salient features of the policy was made by Dr. Rajendra N. Pramanik, PIC – Outreach.

He also briefed the Board of the Policy and Guidelines for *Executive Degree Programmes in partnership mode under Continuing Education Programme (CEP)*.

Both the policies were ratified by the Board with the direction to exercise abundant precaution on following points while selecting partners:

- i. Reputation of IIT Patna has to be protected by inserting suitable clauses in the MoU so as to prevent any partner from doing any possible damage to the Institute.
- ii. The extent up to which branding of IIT Patna can be monetized by the partner has to be carefully decided.
- iii. Quality of service provider needs to be maintained. Relations with Non-Performers may be severed promptly to avoid any liability.
- iv. Each MoU has to be carefully worded and vetted legally.

Since the Certificate Courses under Continuing Education Program (CEP) is a new and good initiative, its execution and progress must be monitored closely and its outcome should be reported in the respective BoGs.

Action taken: Observations raised during last meeting were addressed up to satisfaction of the BoG.

BOG 2022.41.04	<i>To Consider and approve 9th Convocation of the Institute, to be held on 7th December 2022</i>
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The Institute's 9th convocation will be held on, 7th December 2022 at IIT Patna. Mr. Jalaj A. Dani, Member of National Skill Development Agency and Chairman at Addverb Technologies Ltd. will grace the occasion as Chief Guest. Dr. G Satheesh Reddy, Secretary, Department of Defence, R&D, Govt. of India will grace the occasion as Guest of Honour.

The Board approved 9th Convocation.

BOG 2022.41.05	<i>To consider and approve the list of students, to be awarded various Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Doctoral Degrees, during 9th Convocation of the Institute.</i>
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The senate of the Institute has recommended for award of B.Tech, M.Tech, M.Sc., MS by Research and Ph.D. degrees, on the occasion of 9th convocation of the Institute to be held on 7th December 2022.

The list of degree recipients was placed before the Board and the same was approved. -

It was also noted by the Board that IIT Patna has produced more than 100 Ph.D. in one academic year for the first time since inception and it was appreciated by the Board.

BOG 2022.41.06	<i>To consider and approve the criteria for award of various medals and prizes to the eligible students of UG and PG programs of the Institute and the list of medal recipients for the 9th Convocation.</i>
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Criteria for the award of various medals and prizes to the eligible students of UG and PG programs of the Institute and the list of students whose names have been recommended by the Senate for award of various medals and prizes were placed before the Board.

The Board approved the criteria for award of various medals and prizes including endowment prizes. Any fund received under endowment grant from institution/ individual for the purpose of award should be deposited by the institute on long term basis for tenure of 10 years at a time and the accrued interest may be utilized for the purpose of award. The value of each award should be reviewed after a decade to assess its fund value commensurate with the quantum of award.

BOG 2022.41.07	<i>To consider and approve recommendations of 32nd meeting of Finance Committee to be held on 06th December 2022.</i>
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The Board was briefed about the recommendations of the 32nd meeting of the FC held on 06.12.2022.

The Board approved the recommendations of Finance Committee.

BOG 2022.41.08	<i>To consider and approve recommendation of 30th meeting of Senate held on 01st Aug. 2022.</i>
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Minutes of 30th meeting of Senate held on 1st August 2022 were presented before the Board. The 30th Senate decisions were accepted by the Board. Apart from this, presentation on three specific items of the 30th Senate decision, namely Dual Degree Program, Hybrid UG-PG Program and Financial assistance to the Ph.D. students for attending conferences, were made before the Board by the Dean, Academic.

The presentation was followed by an in-depth discussion on each of the 3 specific items of the presentation with following observation:

- a. The Dual Degree (B.Tech- M.Tech) programs approved by the 30th Senate Meeting was reported to the Board and the Board endorsed the proposal of dual degree programs as a matter of policy.
- b. The financial aspect of conference funding to students for attending conferences was endorsed as recorded in the 30th Senate minutes.
- c. While deliberating on different aspect of the Senate approved Hybrid UG-PG Program in Business Management and Computer Science streams, based on presentation made before the Board, few concerns were expressed by the Chairman, Board of Governors. One of the external Board members (Prof. K.C. Sharma) and two Senate Nominee in the Board also endorsed the proposal. The concerns expressed by the Chairman was explained during presentation following which the Chairman, Board of Governors advised the Director to first create adequate infrastructure and then start the Senate approved programs, without compromising the quality to achieve the MoE mandate of NEP implementation and growth as a sustainable institution. The Director assured the same to the Board and it was agreed upon to begin with the minimum number of programs initially. It was decided by the Board to begin with two hybrid Courses from next academic year and report the progress prior to further expansion.

Further, in the course of deliberation on the hybrid UG-PG Program and pressing load on the faculty members, the Board was apprised that IIT Patna faculty members are already engaged with hybrid/online teaching with other entities outside the institute and source of this information is coming from external agencies instead of the said faculty members. The BoG Chairman took this matter very seriously and stressed the need for prior permission from the competent authority and share the part of honorarium so earned to the institute in accordance with the institute policy. It was decided to invoke disciplinary proceedings, applicable to faculty, staff and officers equally, in case of any violation.

With above observations, minutes of 30th Senate meeting were approved.

BOG 2022.41.09	<i>To consider and approve the re-constitution of B&WC</i>
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The term of present Building & Works Committee, IIT Patna has expired on 13th June, 2022. As per Clause 8 (1) of the Statutes of IIT Patna, the B&WC should have not less than 05 and not more than 07 members, to be appointed by the Board including Director as an ex-officio Chairman of the Committee.

The re-constitution of B&WC, comprising eminent persons of respective fields was proposed as under:

To peruse the status of pending legal matters.

The status of pending legal matters of the institute was placed before the Board.

Board noted with appreciation the closure of 06 cases by Hon'ble Court in favour of the Institute. For early disposal of remaining cases, the Board requested the Director to be in touch with Institute employees who filed writ petitions in their service matters.

BOG 2022.41.13

To consider the increase in sanctioned strength of faculty and non-faculty positions.

Department of Expenditure (Ministry of Finance), Govt., of India vide OM F.No. 7 (2)/E.Coord./2020 dated 04th Sep. 2020 imposed a ban on creation of new posts, except with the approval of Department of Expenditure, in Govt. Offices including CFTIs. This ban covers creation of new post(s) under powers which have been delegated to any organization regardless of the source of such authority or power.

Re-iterating the above referred OM, the MoE vide letter dated 14.10.2022, addressed to Directors of all IITs has directed to send the proposal for creation of faculty/non-faculty positions for taking approval of the Department of Expenditure. A check list has also been provided for this purpose.

In past, vide letter dated 10th June, 2013 of the MoE (erstwhile MHRD), addressed to Directors of all IITs, the power of creation of non-faculty posts in IITs as per section 6 (i) (h) of the IIT act was delegated to the BoG up to the prescribed limit in terms of the ratio; student: faculty: non-faculty:10:1:1.1.

So far the institute has been recruiting faculty and non-faculty positions from time to time with the approval of the BoG. In light of recent communication, a proposal needs to be sent to the MoE for creation of posts within prescribed student, faculty and non-faculty ratio of 10 : 1 : 1.1 commensurate with the present student strength, increased after the cutoff date fixed by the govt. i.e 01.07.2020.

In 2020, the total student strength of IIT Patna was approx. 2000, which has now gone up to over 3000. To fill the serious gap of student: faculty: staff ratio and also to get along with the mandate given in National Education Policy to run interdisciplinary and vocational courses, an immediate recruitment of faculty increasing its strength to 300 and Non- Faculty to 330 is required. Such an increase is also mandatory to impart quality education and match the requirement of NEP-2020, NIRF Ranking and excellence in teaching, research and innovation.

The Board considered the proposal and approved the same for further action.

Current Status :

The MoE vide letter F.No. 11-11/2020-TS-1 dated 20.10.2022 has withdrawn its earlier letter of even number dated 14.10.2022.

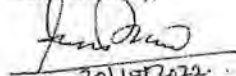

BOG 2022.41.14	<i>To consider and approve the process of engaging Professor of Practice, Adjunct Faculty, Visiting Faculty, Guest Faculty, Chair Professor, Professor of Eminence and HAG Professor.</i>
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In the context of holistic and multidisciplinary education, as recommended in the NEP 2020, it is important for the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) to address the capacity constraints especially with reference to integration of general education with vocational education. Realizing that the HEIs need people with skills and expertise acquired in non-academic careers, in teaching and research, the UGC has taken a new initiative of engaging Professor of Practice in HEIs.

Draft Guidelines for engaging Professor of Practice, Adjunct Faculty, Visiting Faculty, Guest Faculty, Chair Professor, Professor of Eminence and HAG (Higher Administrative Grade) Professor were presented before the Board by Dean, Faculty Affairs. In addition, the constitution of Institute Faculty Affairs Committee (IFAC) and its functions, in line with older IITs was also presented as under:

Composition of IFAC :

(a) Director	- Chairman
(b) Deputy Director (As and when required)	- Member
(c) Dean (Faculty Affairs)	- Member
(d) Dean (Research and Development)	- Member
(e) Head of the Concerned Department	- Member
(f) DR, Admin (for establishment related matters)	- Invited Member

Roles and responsibilities of the IFAC:

- (a) To consider recommendation of the Department for faculty recruitment (all regular positions)
- (b) To consider recommendation of Department regarding confirmation of services of faculty members appointed on probation.
- (c) To consider recommendation of the department, regarding regularization of Assistant Professors appointed in Grade-II
- (d) To consider recommendation of the Department regarding placement of Assistant Professors from Level 12 (AGP Rs. 8000/- pre revised) to Level 13A1 (AGP of Rs. 9,000/-)
- (e) To consider recommendation of the Department regarding appointment of faculty members other than regular viz. Professor of Practice, Adjunct Faculty, Visiting Faculty, Guest Faculty, Chair Professor, Professor of Eminence and HAG (Higher Administrative Grade) Professor.
- (f) To consider recommendation of the department regarding resignation of faculty members.
- (g) To consider recommendation of the department regarding any establishment related matters of faculty members.
- (h) To consider any other matter related to faculty members as referred to by the Director.
- (i) To consider academic matters as and when referred by the Director. Dean, Academic will be invited for any such matters.

An in-depth discussion was held on the proposal and it was appreciated to take it up for healthy competition among faculty for career advancement based on merit. In the matter of recruitment of visiting faculty, guest faculty, Chair Professor, Honorary Professor, Distinguished Professor and Adjunct Professor, a clear procedure is laid down in the IITP Statutes vide clause 17(10) and 18(3).

For visiting faculty selection, IIT Patna Board has laid down a policy, vide its agenda item 2018.28.13 dated 04.06.2018 stating a selection procedure.

The Board deliberated the issue at length considering the provisions laid down above and based on the presentation by the Dean, Faculty Affairs. The Board accepted the proposal with direction to comply the statutory provisions and adopt the MoE/UGC guidelines/orders in the matter of Adjunct Faculty, Professor of Practice and Higher Administrative Grade (HAG) Professors selection. For other positions, a fresh procedure may be laid down in compliance with GoI/ MoE regulations followed by reporting to the Board for ratification at the earliest.

The Board resolved as above.

BOG 2022.41.15	<i>To consider and approve the naming of New Hostels</i>
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While IIT Patna was operating at transit campus, a general decision was taken 'to name the hostels in the remembrance of ancient Indian Scholars of reputation to inculcate the cultural heritage of India' among students and continue with the tradition further. Accordingly, the hostel names were given as Aryabhata, Chanakya, Ashoka, Gautam Buddha, Gargi Halls of Residence drawing lineage from ancient cultural and heritage. This was in practice across various institution of the country such as IITKGP, JNU, IITD etc. However, this generic principle accepted and implemented at IIT Patna was discontinued after shifting to permanent campus from transit campus and the name of existing hostels of transit campus were abandoned. In line of the earlier decision taken while functioning from the transit campus, it has been proposed to name the new boys hostel as **Aryabhata** Hostel and Married Student Hostel as **Ashoka** Hostel.

The Board approved above proposal.

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Action Plan and Action Taken Report are as under:

i. Starting interdisciplinary programs in line with NEP 2020: Minor programs across the disciplines will be started to offer students an interdisciplinary exposure that will lead to innovation.

IIT Patna is introducing Minor Programs open to UG/PG students to create multitasking professionals.

ii. Industry oriented academic programs: New academic programs will be kick-started in collaboration with industries to provide trained manpower for solving live problems in industries.

An M.Tech program in Artificial Intelligence through Technology Innovation Hub has been implemented from Autumn 2022 session. In addition to that new online Academic Programs (UG/PG) in association with Industry and Academic institutes is going to begin very soon.

iii. Opening new academic programs (Executive M-Tech, Hybrid UG/PG and sponsored Ph.D. programs) to fulfil NEP mandate of flexible academic structure.

BoG approved academic vision of the institute is in line with the NEP approval by MoE for implementation. To fulfil this mandate, IIT Patna has already undertaken initiatives to start Executive M-Tech, Hybrid UG/PG and sponsored Ph.D. programs to become a partner in upskilling working professionals and also to provide multiple learning opportunities to young generation of student with an aim to create multi-tasking

professionals in near future. To implement this objective, few executive M.Tech programs (Mechatronics, Artificial intelligence and PG diploma in Human Resource Management) has already been announced for admission and other programmes are in pipeline to be started from next academic year. Program structure has been rigorously designed with input from subject experts with clearly defined PLO (Program Learning objectives and Outcome) & CLO (Course Learning Objectives and Outcome) and mapping of CLO with PLO.

iv. Joint Ph.D. programs with national and international universities: New joint programs will be started to foster collaboration with acclaimed national and international universities.

The proposed agenda item was discussed at length and the idea of joint Ph.D. and Joint PG (M.Tech/M.Sc.) program was considered to be pursued in the larger interest of the institute visibility and to foster and collaborate with academic institution of repute at national and international level. The Board was reported that one such initiative with ISEN France is already in place for a student. However, the Board advised to have standard MoU for such initiative with specific object-oriented terms and condition to be incorporated on bilateral basis with collaborative institutions.
